- Timely and accurate processing of all in-store orders; including retrieval of stocked items and proper documenting of parts requiring order. Accurately completes orders by communicating with customers on parts delivery status and customer pick up instructions.
- Maintains inventory integrity by verifying receipting-in of shipments and verifying accuracy of packing slips against shipped products.



- Actively assists with placing parts orders in proper inventory locations; assisting in cycle counts; follow up on inventory discrepancies and expediting issues by reporting to Supervisor/Manager.
- Assists with preparing and maintaining professional showroom image and merchandise displays.
- Assists in keeping parts department clean and orderly.
- Receive, sort, and store incoming parts and supplies in an orderly and accessible manner in the warehouse, supply room, or stockroom.
